Beech Manor is an 8-bedded 24hr residential step down unit with nursing, situated on the borders of Sutton in Carshalton Beeches.

The emphasis of treatment is to provide residents with a service that assesses needs based on a shared pathway. It is a stepping stone to independent living.

At Beech Manor we understand that partnership working between the resident, the staff team, internal and external professionals, visitors and regulating bodies is fundamental to a person's continued progress.

We also recognise that this is necessary to ensure we provide residents with a safe and therapeutic environment,

We will work towards enabling all residents to set and achieve their own goals and manage their own care according to their own optimal level of functioning. This places them at the very centre of their care.

We are committed to maximising residents' involvement in the provision and delivery of their care. To this end they will be valued, treated equally as individuals and with respect, regardless of age, ethnicity, disability, culture or sexual orientation.

Our vision is to treat all our residents as individuals. We welcome those people who are lesbian, gay, bisexual and trans-sexual at Beech Manor. All individuals will receive good quality care, can talk openly with health professionals without judgement and be treated with respect by staff they can trust.

who is our service for?

We support people over the age of 18 years who have complex and ongoing mental health needs.

We offer a therapeutic environment where residents are encouraged and empowered to live as independently as possible and make real progress in their ongoing recovery whilst continuing to cope with possible symptoms of mental health issues.

the environment

Beech Manor is situated in Carshalton Beeches where there is a thriving and busy local community, close to Sutton with its many amenities. There are excellent transport links to London.

Residents may personalise their room and there is free WiFi in all areas. We have weekly community meetings when we discuss and plan ahead together.

our aims:

Our aim is to provide residents with an excellent and professional standard of care in a homely and friendly environment where rights, choices and privacy are respected.

We hope residents' time within our service is positive and productive. It is our aim that you feel respected, empowered and valued in order to build relationships which can help your journey with us and ensure you will be best placed to make the next step when the time is right.



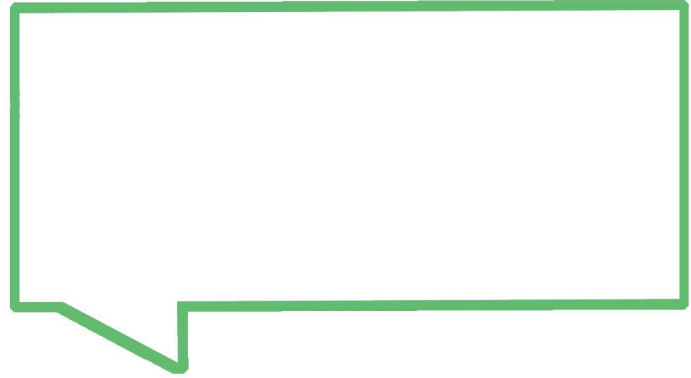
catering for everyone:

At Beech Manor we take healthy eating & nutrition very seriously. Residents are encouraged to plan, shop and cook their own meals. Staff will offer support where required.



maintaining quality:

We have achieved an overall CQC rating of GOOD for which we are very proud. Quality Assurance and Governance processes are in place to ensure the quality and safety of the services we deliver at Beech Manor. Staff training is of high quality and our compliance is consistently over 90%. UK Government COVID-19 guidance is effectively adhered to.



activities & visiting:

The team at Beech Manor will encourage residents to use the community to gain continued confidence in making links with the world outside of a care setting.

We hope that over time, a resident's ability to function as independently as possible will be achieved and to understand that community access is an important factor in supporting that aim.

external healthcare professionals:

All our residents are registered with a local GP practice who will deal with any physical healthcare needs outside our remit.

We have links with dentists and opticians, and chiropodists.

Our aim is to provide assistance to develop skills in relapse prevention, preventing re-offending, increasing skills relating to activities of daily living, such as cooking and budgeting and in building support networks within the community.

Visitors are welcome. We understand that having important people around us is a huge part of feeling valued.
